QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS:

1. Question: Can you please provide the "as build" drawings?

Answer: Yes, please refer to the added attachment r., Original 1937 Drawings, included in this addendum.

2. Question: Can the asbestos survey be uploaded to CivCast for review?

Answer: Yes, please refer to the added attachment q., Asbestos Survey and Floor Plan, included in this addendum.

3. Question: Will the floors be clear of all debris after asbestos abatement is complete?

Answer: No.

4. Question: The bid documents say that the trees on the street are to be protected and remain, will alternate proposals to replace the trees be considered? Or relocated temporarily and reinstall?

Answer: Trees are property of the City of Houston. The Tree Protection Ordinance as contained in sections V and VI of Chapter 33 of the City of Houston Code of Ordinances pertains to the protection and preservation of trees and shrubs on city property.

5. Question: The bid documents state only hand demolition; will implosion proposals be considered?

Answer: No.

6. Question: Will project specifications be issued for this project?

Answer: Yes, please refer to attachment m., General Notices, Notes & Information.

7. Question: The Contract Documents on sheet A1.01 Keyed Notes 5, 6 and 7 refer to Parking Control Systems. These notes reference a specification section. Will this be provided prior to the bid date?

Answer: The Parking Control Equipment specifications is included in section 11 12 00.

8. Question: Has ACM sampling been completed on the insulation at the Chilled Water, Steam, and Condensate Drain piping that is shown to be demolished in the Family Law Building?

Answer: Yes.

9. Question: The Contract Documents reference the GeoTechnical Report. Will this be provided prior to the bid date?

<u>Answer</u>: The geotechnical report, from Raba Kistner, is included in the specifications, section 00 31 32.
